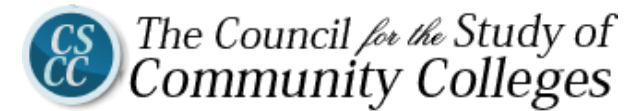
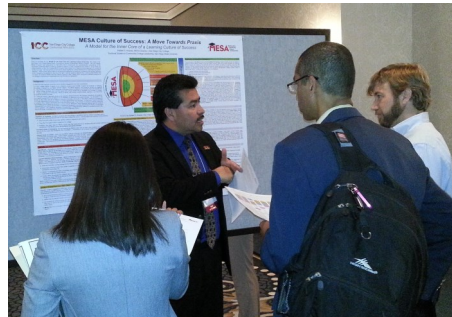

## HOW TO JOIN

CSCC membership is open to all professionals involved in community college education. Membership is annual, on a calendar year basis. There are four membership categories:

- 1) Institutional - \$250 Open to colleges or universities paying for multiple members in the Council. (Institutional membership covers up to three people per institution.)
- 2) Individual - \$125 Open to any professional working with community college education or interested in the study of community colleges.
- 3) Graduate Student - \$60 Open to enrolled graduate students interested in community college education.
- 4) Emeritus - \$60 Open to retired university professors or community college educators.
